SPATIAL ORDER

Shows the layout of anything that takes up space. Use spatial order to present physical objects in a way that makes sense: bottom to top, left to right, background to foreground, outside to inside – in short, in any organized fashion.

DOMINANT IMPRESSION

- Description more than a tangle of unrelated details
- Details should convey a single dominant impression
