- Explain the responsibilities and qualifications.
- Also, list the advantages of sailing on the mighty seas.
- Be creative!

Consider the following items in you listing:

- 1. Post a job title that clear, direct, and specific.
- 2. Provide a thorough job description.
- 3. List previous experience that is helpful for the applicant.
- 4. Discuss the benefits and opportunities associated with this line of work.
